2013 marks the 35th anniversary of this golf outing. In January 1979, several trustees of the local chapter of the Leukemia Society of America (now known as The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society), along with the Western PA Oldsmobile Dealerships, gathered to plan the first ever Leukemia Golf Open. With 22 foursomes, the premier venue net \$9,000. This began a long tenure of great leadership, great golf venues and phenomenal fund raising for research funding. Thirty-four tournaments later, in 2012, under the leadership of Joe Curtin and Doug Matthews, the annual golf tournament raised more than \$380,000. Since the inception of this event, over \$4 million has been raised for blood cancer research and patient programs.
