Research

As there are no means of preventing or early screening for most blood cancers, the LLS research agenda is focused on finding cures. LLS identifies and funds the most promising blood cancer research projects and forges partnerships with academic institutions, biotechnology and pharmaceutical companies to accelerate the development of new therapies.

Patient Access

LLS is the leading source of free, highly specialized blood cancer information, education and support for patients, survivors, families and professionals. We help patients identify resources and access treatment and support through financial assistance programs, First Connection, support groups, and LLS Community. LLS sponsors free patient, caregiver and healthcare professional education programs locally. Honored Hero Program

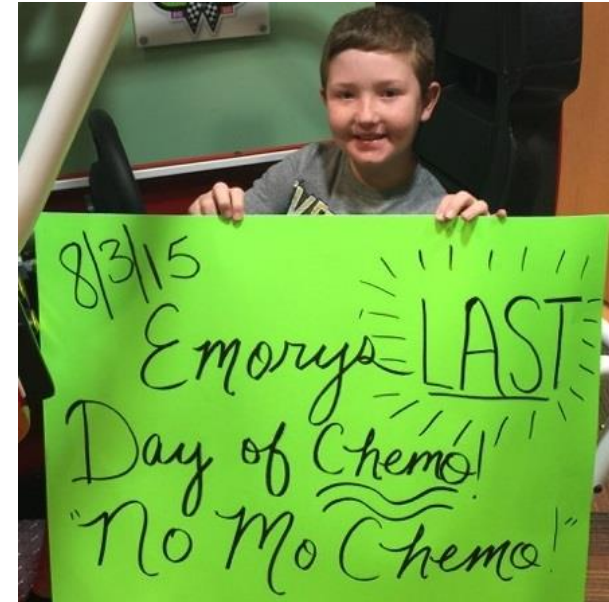
An Honored Hero is a dedicated individual or family member, affected by a blood cancer, who serves as an inspiration and provides support to LLS.

Students of the Year campaign is a student-led leadership initiative in which nominated high school students participate in a six week fundraising competition to benefit LLS's mission.

Candidates raise money in honor of a local teen patient hero who is currently battling a blood cancer. This program is for local area high school students enrolled in private or public schools who are enthusiastic about volunteerism, philanthropy, community outreach, and leadership!
