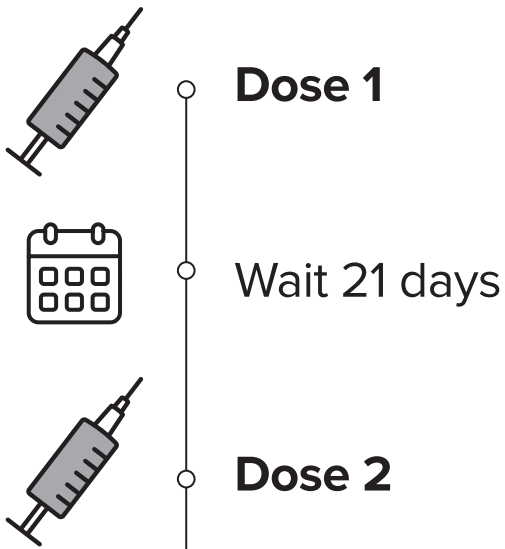


COVID-19 VACCINATION SCHEDULE FOR MODERATELY TO SEVERELY IMMUNOCOMPROMISED PATIENTS

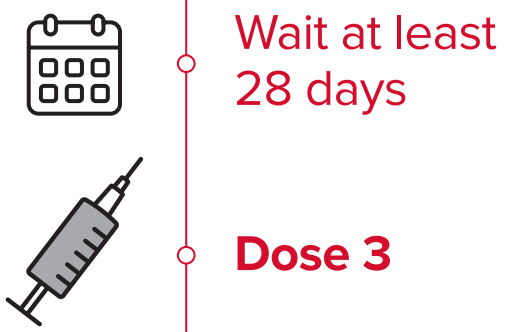
Includes blood cancer patients and most survivors*

Wait at least 3 months

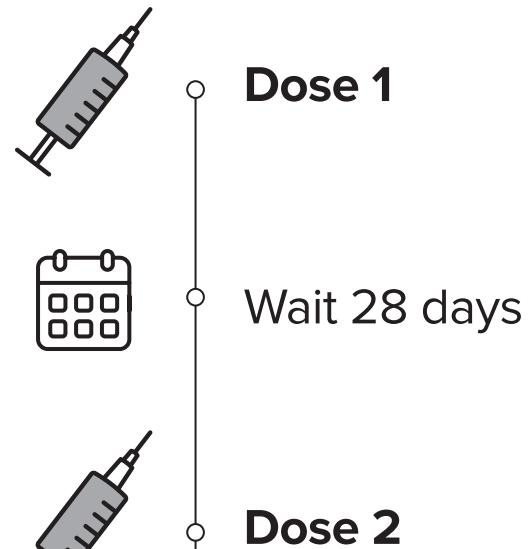


Additional booster dose for immunocompromised patients

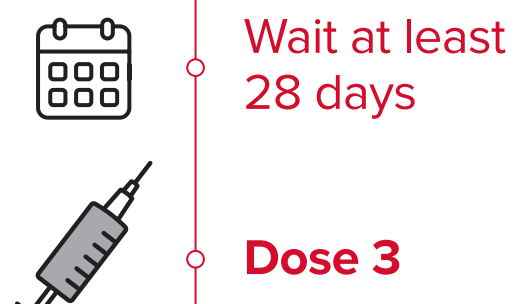


Moderna (mRNA)

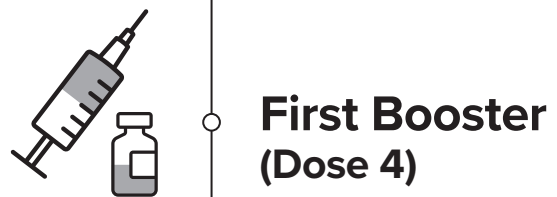
For ages 18 and up



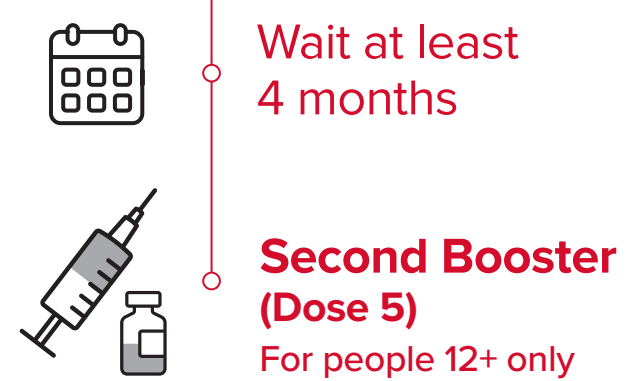
Additional dose for immunocompromised patients

Boosters may be “mixed and matched.”

Moderna boosters are a half-dose; Pfizer boosters are a regular dose.

Revaccination may be considered for patients who received one or more doses of COVID-19 vaccine while they were being treated with B-cell depleting therapies like rituximab or ocrelizumab. A patient’s own oncologist is the best person to determine whether and when revaccination should happen.
