#### WHO:

Local area high school students enrolled in private or public schools who are enthusiastic about volunteerism, philanthropy, community outreach, and leadership!

#### WHAT:

The Student of the Year Campaign is a six-week initiative in which nominated high school students participate in a fundraising competition to benefit The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's (LLS) Georgia Chapter. Nominated students are selected as Student of the Year candidates via the LLS selection committee. Selection is based upon a questionnaire and essay submitted by each interested student. Candidates will raise money in honor of a patient hero who is currently battling or is in remission from a blood cancer. The candidate who raises the most money at the end of the six weeks is named Student of the Year. In addition, there are Citizenship Awards for the student candidates who excel in Volunteerism, Community Involvement, and Mission Focus.

#### WHEN:

Application Deadline – Friday, October 16, 2015 Candidates Announced – Monday, November 2, 2015 Campaign Launch— Thursday, January 14, 2016 Grand Finale Gala -- Friday, February 26, 2016

#### WHY:

To join the fight against cancer and improve the quality of life for our patients and their families. Leukemia is the number one cancer killer of our children under the age of 20; therefore kids are helping kids battling these devastating cancers. To boost the college applications with a leadership and philanthropic adventure. Candidates are eligible for scholarship awards. The Student of the Year will receive a \$5,000 scholarship toward the college or university of his/her choice. Each Citizenship Award winner will receive a \$2,500 scholarship toward the college or university of his/her choice. Every candidate who reaches the minimum fundraising requirement of \$10,000 will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.

#### HOW:

Students rally their communities, schools and families to support their fundraising efforts. Along with their own web sites, students will work with LLS staff to set a fundraising goal and to develop an action plan to reach that goal. LLS will provide fundraising materials and support throughout the campaign. The easiest ways to fundraise are through a letter writing/email campaign, company sponsorship, and social networking. Each candidate and their campaign team will brainstorm with LLS to determine a plan for success.
