One-Day Event Volunteering:

One of the main ways that volunteers support our chapter is by assisting us at LLS special events. These events are typically one day only and are supported almost entirely by volunteers. It is always important that we have great people to help out! Volunteers may help with event registration, passing out t-shirts/refreshments, setting up/cleaning up the event space, and more!

Joining an Event Committee:

Committee members are longer-term volunteers who help fundraise for events, recruit participants, and plan event logistics. Committee members also serve as ambassadors for LLS by promoting events within their communities and securing donations/sponsorships.
